

Participant Code of Conduct

1. Respect One Another:

Treat each other as you would like to be treated • Don't take or borrow anything that doesn't belong to you without permission • Don't insult or criticize • Be careful that your joking isn't hurtful to others • Bullying and harassing behaviors will not be allowed.

2. Respect Your Surroundings:

Respect and do not harm any property, nature or person • Leave all animals alone • Help keep the boat and vehicle clean by using properly marked containers for garbage and recyclables • Don't leave food or garbage • We are guests of our lakes.

3. Safety:

No swimming • Participants must be accompanied by an adult on the boat at all times • Life vests are required to be worn in the boat at all times • RLI staff needs to know where you are at all times. • Drugs, alcohol, and cigarettes are strictly prohibited • Weapons are strictly prohibited (including explosive devices and firecrackers) • No horseplay on the boat or dock.

4. Electronics & Prohibited Items:

Phones should be silenced and put away during programming and while on the boat • RLI is not responsible for lost or damaged items • RLI staff reserves the right to hold inappropriate personal items of participants. Return of the item will, if appropriate, be made at the end of the day. Parent/guardian contact and authorization may be necessary for this return.

5. After Fishing:

Help RLI staff and other participants put away equipment after fishing • Keep the noise down when returning to the dock.

6. Attire:

Dress appropriately for the weather (layers are recommended) • Shoes must be always worn except for at the beach.

7. Language:

Use kind language at all times • Profanity, vulgarity, sexual innuendo, racist, or sexist remarks will never be tolerated.
